There are new releases coming for the SailTimer app on iOS and Android, and we are broadening the design for all types of boats: kayaks, aluminum fishing boats, waterski boats, cabin cruisers, sportfishers, and commercial work boats.

All other apps and weather services show the same satellite weather. So this sneak peak and the other short videos in the series will show you some new capabilities with accurate, high-resolution wind maps that have never been possible until now.
